- How might God be calling you to take on the mantle of entertaining angels unaware, through what you serve at parties and more?
- What if God is standing before you, with arms open, ready to receive your harm and shame. Will you trust God to heal you?
- What if every person standing in front of you is worthy of freedom from harm and shame just like you. Will you see them as a beloved child of God for whom Christ died?
- What if the mirror in front of you wishes to show you a beloved child of God for whom Christ died. Will you make eye contact?
- What if God is standing before you, to show you the only love that stands a chance at delivering on its promises. Will you dare to receive it?
